Tardies will be documented and tracked starting this week, September 5, 2018.

- Any student entering the building after the drop off whistle at 8:32, **MUST** be walked in by a parent/guardian and signed in at the front desk computers.

Uniforms Expectation



InshaAllah students and parents have settled in and transitioned into the routines of the new school year. Al Fatih Academy expects that each student Kindergarten through 8th grade follows the school uniform policy at all times.

Beginning September 10th, parents of any student not in accordance with the school uniform policy will receive a violation email. After the 3rd email, the student will be asked to remain in the lobby until a parent or family member is able to bring a change of clothes for the student.
