AFA-Virtual School Anticipated Schedule

Week 1: March 16-20

- Gradual onboarding for parents and students of platforms and expectations.
- Parents can expect check-ins from administration, teachers, PE/Art, and counselors during this week.
- No formal instruction

Week 2: March 23-27

- Teachers contact students using Zoom.
- Share instructional resources that students can use for parent-guided and selfguided learning
- links to resources and activities that will allow students to practice skills, review content and explore topics at home.

Week 3: March 20-Apr 3

- More formal instruction implemented
- Details to be shared by teachers

Supporting AFA'ers Wellness

Counselors

Questions from Zoom Session II (not brought up in recorded Session I)

1. What will happen to science fair?

We will send info about alternative set up

2. Will tuition payments be impacted?

As of now there is no change in tuition payments. We recognize some families may incur some difficulties due to their employment status. Please reach out to admin if this becomes an issue

3. Will standardized testing be canceled?

Currently no decision has been made to change the date or cancel testing. However postponing testing or canceling are all options depending on how the situation evolves.

4. Will the students be graded on any of this?

For the first two weeks all students will not be graded. Afterwards teachers will share info about assessments as they are developed.

5. Do these virtual sessions count as instructional days as defined by the state?

The virtual session days over the next two weeks do not count as instructional days as per the state's (mandate to not count the 2 weeks) so therefore we are not defining them as such. We are using this time, however, to establish the framework for week 3 (and beyond if necessary)

6. Is the MS resource period mandatory? Or only if you have questions, etc.? Will MS receive instruction during online sessions. Is that when they will receive assignments/hw?

Resource is not mandatory. Yes, during the live sessions students will receive initial info about an assignment. However, anything from the live session would be posted in Google Classroom and RenWeb in case a student is unable to join a live session.

7. Can any of the elementary grades also get (daily) live sessions similar to the middle schoolers?

There will not be live sessions for elementary at this time. (however teachers are preparing to include these as soon as possible).
